### **Youth club**

Seeds4Success, a local youth work charity, have 2 different projects that can be accessed by children from Chilmark School. There is a weekly junior youth club session for young people in School Years 6,7 & 8 which runs from 6 – 8pm on a Tuesday evening and there is a monthly junior youth club in Mere from 6-7:30pm on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Wednesday of the month for children in year 5,6 & 7.
