2017 combined maths/reading/writing score 60%	2016 combined 44%
2017 writing 90%	2016 writing 55%
2017 reading 80%	2016 reading 66%
2017 spelling and grammar 70%	2016 spelling and grammar 33%
2017 maths 60%	2016 maths 55%

Well done Year Six! These results are dramatically better than last year and demonstrate that the new approaches that the school has adopted have made a significant difference.
